I bought a new dress <u>yesterday</u>	When did you buy a new dress?
I went <u>to paris.</u>	Where did you go?
My computer costs <u>200 euros</u>	How much does it cost?
I drank <u>two coke.</u>	How many cokes did you drink?
I <u>drank</u> two coke.	What did you do ?
I drank <u>two coke.</u>	What did you drink ?
I went to the hospital <u>because I have broken my leg.</u>	Why did you go to the hospital?
<u>My parents</u> want to go to England.	Who wants to go to England?
<u>I</u> ate two cookies.	Who ate two cookies?
I saw <u>Peter</u> yesterday.	Who did you see yesterday?
I went out <u>with my uncle.</u>	Who did you go out with?
He is <u>four feet tall.</u>	How tall is he ?
She goes to the cinema <u>once a week.</u>	How often does she go to the cinema?
She went to the cinema <u>twice</u> last month.	How many times did she go to the cinema last month ?
She stayed there <u>for five</u> months.	How long did she stay there?

I went there <u>three months ago</u>	When did you go there?
I went there <u>three months</u> ago	How long ago did you go there?
I went there <u>three</u> months ago	How many months ago did you go there?
He arrived at <u>8 o'clock</u>	What time did he arrive?
They <u>are talking</u> together.	What are they doing?
He started <u>working in this shop.</u>	What did he start?
She always <u>tidies</u> her room.	What does she always do?

She can swim <u>in the lake</u>	Where can she swim?
They could <u>go out</u> at night	Where could they go at night?
I would like <u>to be an architect</u>	What would you like to be?
They should <u>work harder</u>	What should they do?

Attention : Can, could (can au passé), should, would sont des auxiliaires donc il ne faut pas rajouter d'auxiliaire dans la question, ce sont eux qui font le boulot 😊
